Homeland Security Updates

HSA/IEMA-OHS Director Tate-Nadeau briefed attendees on the heightened potential for homegrown violent extremism related to the Israel-Hamas conflict as well as an escalation in malinformation aimed at sowing divisiveness among religious communities.

Chief Intelligence Officer Aaron Kustermann, Illinois State Police - State Terrorism and Intelligence Center, provided an intelligence briefing.

Deputy Director of Homeland Security Claire Moravec highlighted a joint community-based violence prevention workshop that took place earlier in the week with funding support from the HSAC. This event at the University of Chicago included several counties and focused on building out behavioral threat assessment teams and delving into community-based violence prevention methods.

Old Business

• Unmet Needs Request for FFY 20 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) and SFY 24 Preparedness and Response (PAR) reallocations

Motion to approve the unmet needs prioritized list with the understanding that the Council of Chairs will be kept updated on the status of the list with the option to modify it.

New Business

Homeland Security Strategy Review Process – Chairman Page and Deputy Director Moravec explained
that the IEMA-OHS Office of Homeland Security staff has been working on a 2024-2028 draft strategy. It
is currently going through an initial review process with the Public Safety Executive Committee and will
then come to the HSAC for final approval. Depending on the timing of HSAC meetings, Page posed the
possibility of delegating the final approval to the Council of Chairs – after review by HSAC committees.

Motion to delegate to the Council of Chairs the final decision of recommending the IEMA-OHS Homeland Security Strategy after review by the Committees.

- FEMA Guidance on Using SHSP and UASI for Civil Disorder-Related Overtime Chairman Page said that this guidance will be sent out to the HSAC membership. He stressed that agencies considering using federal preparedness funds for such purposes need to obtain preapproval.
- The 2024 HSAC Meeting Schedule was presented.
- 2023 IL-HSAC Annual Report Chairman Page stressed that submissions this year should be organized by Vision 2025 goals. He said he will send out further instructions, in addition to organizations' Attachment A's, to help them effectively organize their reports. Last year's report, located on the IEMA-

OHS website, can be referred to as an example. Page and Director Tate-Nadeau emphasized the importance of the annual report in justifying requests for additional funding.

• Chairman Page reminded members about the OneNet training requirement. Many members have not yet completed their annual training.

 - O Scott Clarke, Red Cross nationwide Red Cross policy change allowing pets in shelters. However, shelters are not owned by Red Cross, so owners must consent to housing pets.
 - o Ted Berger, Cook County evaluating approximately 40 applications totaling \$50 million in requests for homeland security funding
 - Natalie Gutierrez, City of Chicago update on air assets for Chicago; OEMC will host a whole community summit on NIU campus, Nov. 16
