## NOTICE

Re: Material False Statements and Altering of Credentials

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to notify all persons of Section 39 of the Radiation Protection Act of 1990 (Act), 420 ILCS 40/1 et seq, which provides criminal penalties for certain violations.

The following is a criminal offense under Section 39:

Any person who knowingly makes a false material statement to an Agency employee during the course of official Agency business or in an application for accreditation, certification, registration, or licensure under the Act.

Any person who knowingly alters a credential, certificate, registration, or license issued by the Agency for the purpose of evading a requirement of this Act.

A person who violates any part of this statutory section is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor for the first offense and is guilty of a Class 4 felony for a second or subsequent offense. 420 ILCS 40/39(b)(1)-(2).
